Letter for potential organizations

VIA e.V. organizes temporary stays abroad in which the participants are given the opportunity to establish close contacts with citizens of another country and therefore gain insight in a different living environment. We work closely with partners and projects worldwide in a multitude of programs in Germany, other parts of Europe, Australia, New Zealand, North and Central America, Africa and Asia.

As many young Germans are highly motivated to spend a **volunteer year abroad and support their hosting organization** in various ways, we are steadily looking for new partnerships in the domains of education, health, environment, agriculture, sports, culture or human rights.

The program is called **International Youth Voluntary Service (IJFD)** (in English: <https://www.ijfd-info.de/ijfd-in-english-language.html>) and is mostly funded and co-financed by the Federal Ministry for Family, Youth, Senior citizens and Women. Additionally we ask our volunteers to find contributors who will support their voluntary service with a small donation.

Volunteers go through orientation trainings in Germany before they go abroad. We will also cover for their insurance and their travel costs to and from the project. Furthermore we support the volunteers at their visa application process.

We would ask the hosting organization, you, to cover the accommodation, board and a pocket money. The volunteers would stay 9-12 month. The hosting organization does not need to cover any further costs or fees.

The volunteers render a full time service (35 to 40 hours per week) and usually get off two days a week. They may work in shifts and on weekends depending on the project.

They neither get any remuneration for their work nor do they negatively effect the labour market in the host country, since their work is only an ancillary activity.

We do already cooperate with several NGOs where we place our volunteers. They support people with mental or physical disabilities, for example in Arche or Camphill Communities, in Independent Living Projects, homeless people in shelters or resocializing programs, elderly people, students in boarding schools, children in pre-schools, youth hostels etc.
